## Criteria for Shortlisting

In addition to the eligibility criteria listed in <u>admissions brochure for the MS/PhD program</u>, the CSE department applies the following criteria for shortlisting.

## **Notes**

- Conversion from CGPA to Percentage: As per IITM norms, all CGPAs are converted to Percentages as follows. If the CGPA is X out of 10, then the corresponding percentage is (X-0.5)\*100. CGPAs in scales other than 10, will be linearly scaled to 10 before applying the above conversion formula.
- Qualification by Masters Degree: In cases where the masters degree is the qualifying degree for the
  candidate as per the <u>admissions brochure</u>, the value of UG in the above criterion will be the marks obtained in
  the masters degree.
