Criteria for Shortlisting

In addition to the eligibility criteria listed in [admissions brochure for the MS/PhD program](#), the CSE department applies the following criteria for shortlisting.

App Type	Category	Criterion
Full-Time	General	(UG > 60 AND GS > 450) OR (IIT CGPA > 8.0)
	PD or OBC/SC/ST	(UG > 55 AND GS > 425) OR (IIT CGPA > 7.5)
External/Part-Time	General	(UG > 60)
	PD or OBC/SC/ST	(UG > 55)
Project	General	(UG > 60) AND (Employed on a Project at IITM)
	PD or OBC/SC/ST	(UG > 55) AND (Employed on a Project at IITM)

where UG stands for the marks in UG in percentage (see notes below) and GS stands for the GATE score.

Notes

- *Conversion from CGPA to Percentage* : As per IITM norms, all CGPAs are converted to Percentages as follows. If the CGPA is X out of 10, then the corresponding percentage is $(X-0.5)*100$. CGPAs in scales other than 10, will be linearly scaled to 10 before applying the above conversion formula.
- *Qualification by Masters Degree* : In cases where the masters degree is the qualifying degree for the candidate as per the [admissions brochure](#), the value of UG in the above criterion will be the marks obtained in the masters degree.
